- **HSER 331 Human Services Group Practicum & Seminar**

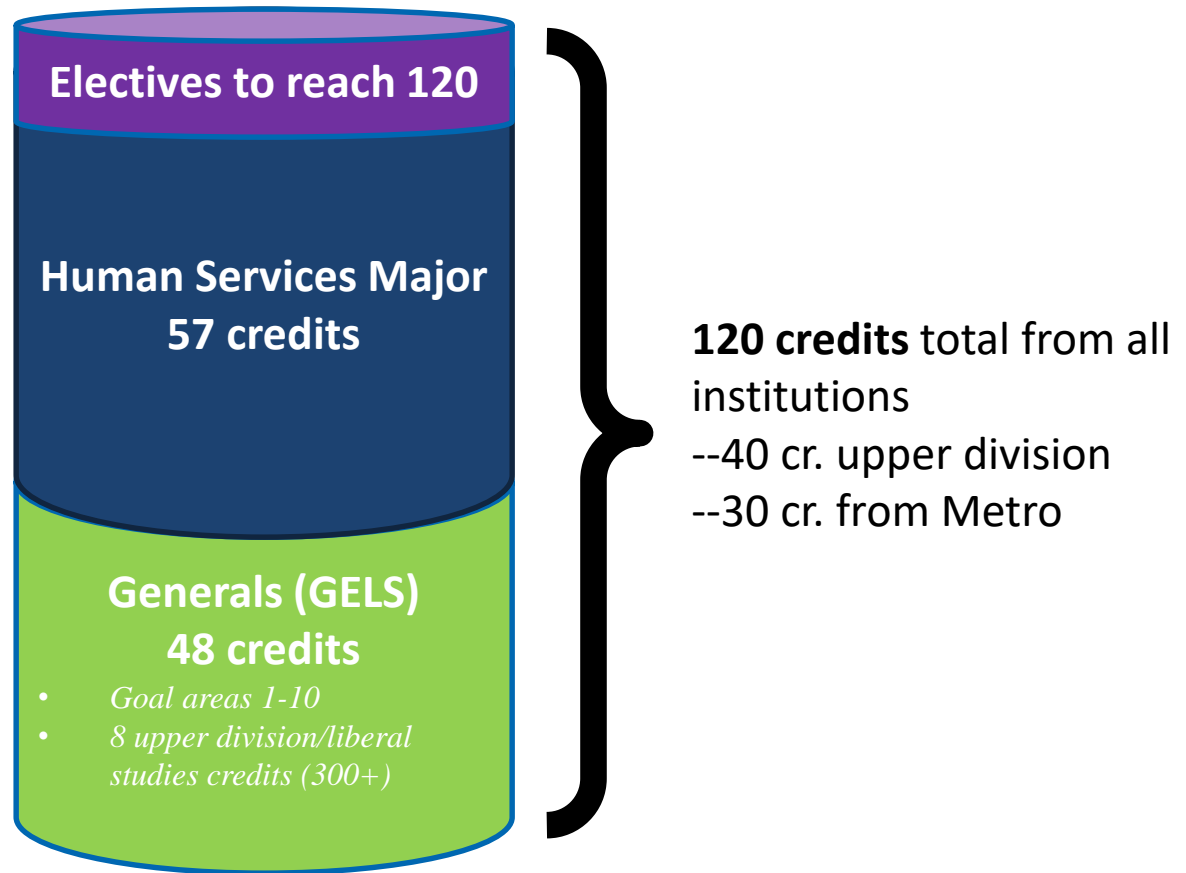
Notes:
