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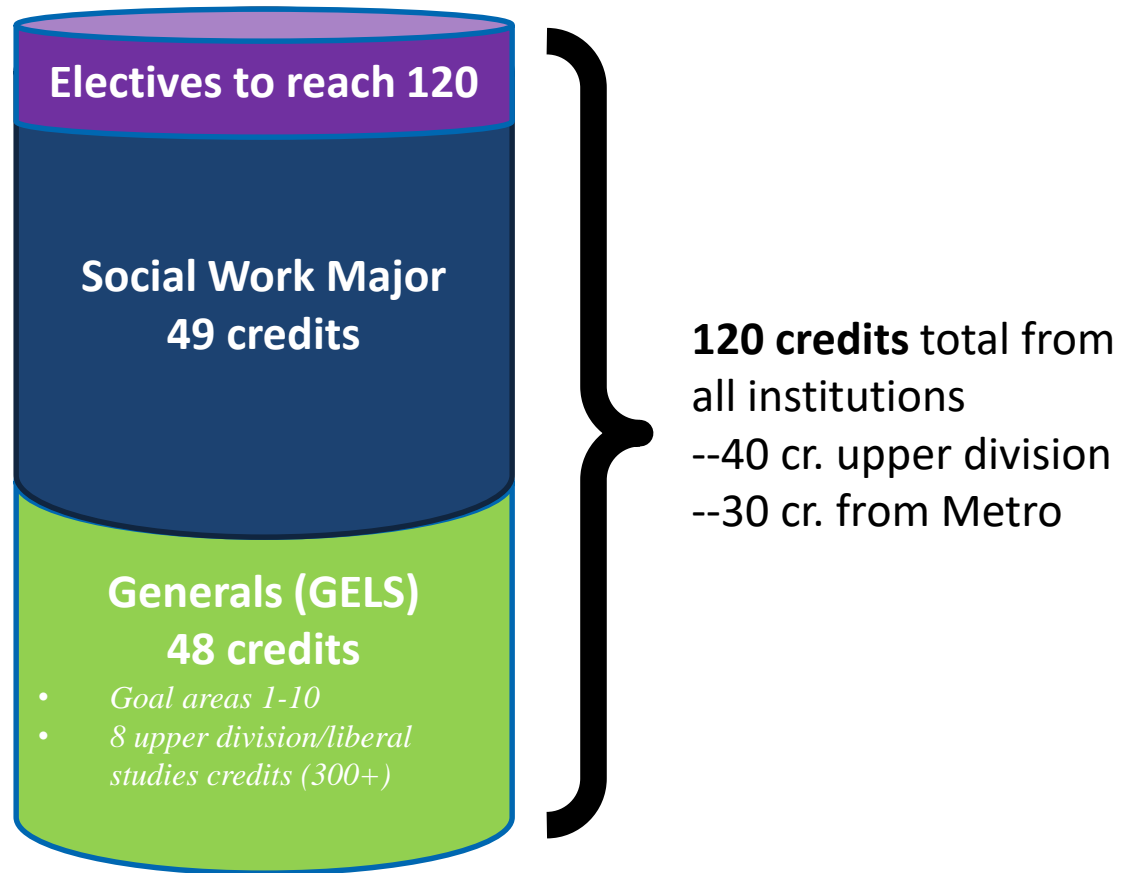

Application Requirements

Prerequisite Courses

- Intro to Social Work from Metro State or Intro to Human Services from a community college
- U.S./American Government – Political Science
- Human Biology or Biology of Women
- Lifespan/Developmental Psychology
- A Psychology course (other than Developmental Psyc.)
- A Sociology course
- A Diversity/Racial/Ethnic Awareness course

Other Application Requirements

- Minimum of 60 credits completed
- Statistics – this course is not required to be admitted to the program, but it is required to graduate.

Social Work Application Process

- Submit the [Social Work application form](#) by the deadline
- Include two Letters of Recommendation
- Show evidence of work, life and/or volunteer experience with communities of color
- Include the 500 word personal essay
- Complete an interview with a Social Work faculty member

Social Work – Other Details

- Fall Start = October 15th is the Application Deadline
- Spring Start = March 15th is the Application Deadline
- In the fall semester there is 1 full-time cohort and 1 part-time cohort (54 students)
- In the spring semester there is 1 full-time cohort (27 students)
- Cohort model – you will complete the Social Work program with the same group of students
